



Challenge and Solution

Challenge: Track, acknowledge, and respond to the 12-Year Program (TYP) Survey mapped points and manage high volumes of public feedback across many Districts and MPO/RPOs.

Solution: Create a centralized system for tracking Triage points and Responses to the public comment mapped issues from the TYP public comment period.

9,186 participants, **3,710** mapped issues, **82** already addressed



Online Public Forum

8,000+ participants, **120+** questions

3,710 comments tagged for follow-up
